FESTIVAL GUIDELINES & INFORMATION

Products in various craft and retail categories are limited to maintain a balance in the show. As categories fill, we will make posts on our social media pages and website, and additional applications will be wait listed.

If you and another vendor would like adjoining spaces, please write this on your application.

Vendors must furnish their own free-standing tents (with weights), tables and displays. All items, tables, displays, chairs and boxes must remain inside your vending area at all times. Nothing can block sidewalks or roadways.

Raffles are limited to non-profit/civic groups and must be approved before applying.

Soliciting/distribution of materials or products outside of allotted vendor space is not allowed.

Our Vendor Coordinators will contact vendors directly when their application has been approved for the event. **Until you are contacted, you are not approved.**

You may only vend the items listed on your application, be sure you make a complete list.

NO vendor can sell items using the Festival name or logo.

Vendors must register at the Information Booth before setting up.

Booth assignments will be given at sign-in.

The Poke Salat Festival Committee reserves the right to ask you to remove items from your booth that may be considered to be in poor taste. This is a family oriented event and all items must be acceptable for all ages.

Vendor check-in will be Saturday morning, May 16th, 5:00 am – 8:30 am. Cars must be out of the Festival area by 8:30 am and will not be allowed in again until 6 pm when the Festival closes.

Booth assignments are given at check-in.

No vendor or group may give away food products or drinks, except samples by food truck vendors.

The Poke Salat Festival is an outside event, held rain or shine.

No refunds are given.
